

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR
THE CITY OF NORTH VANCOUVER HELD IN THE CITY HALL ON MONDAY
THE 8TH DAY OF JULY 1907 AT 4 O'CLOCK P.M.**

The Mayor, Commissioners and Clerk made the Statutory declarations.

Applications for renewal of Hotel Licenses were submitted for P. Larson, Hotel North Vancouver and L. Reeda, Palace Hotel.

A letter from Chief of Police Davies was read with reference to gambling in the Hotel premises on Dominion Day, July 1st.

The Commissioners granted a renewal to 31st December next, of the Hotel North Vancouver License.

The License for the Palace Hotel was renewed to 31st December next, on the strict understanding that Mr. Reeda conduct his premises in accordance with the conditions of his Hotel License. The Clerk was instructed to inform Mr. Reeda that an irregularity, in allowing gambling on his premises on July 1st had been reported to the Board and that a black mark had been noted against him.
