

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL, HELD IN THE CITY HALL,  
ON MONDAY THE 26<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF AUGUST 1907 AT 8:30 O'CLOCK P.M.**

The Mayor presiding and all the Aldermen present.

A letter was read from Constable Tarn reporting that the electric street lights were not burning until 9:30 p.m. on the 23<sup>rd</sup> inst. and 8:30 p.m. on the 25<sup>th</sup> inst.

The Clerk was instructed to write to the B.C. Electric Railway Co. and call their attention to the inadequate service of Street Cars, which at present exists in the City, and to point out that the Council consider the time has now arrived when longer cars should be run on all sections of the service.

The Council discussed at considerable length, matters relating to the present Ferry service and Ferry landings, and what course of action should be taken to improve the same.
