

**MINUTES OF STATUTORY QUARTERLY MEETING OF BOARD OF
LICENSING COMMISSIONS HELD WITHIN THE CITY HALL ON
WEDNESDAY THE 11TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1907 AT
5:00 O'CLOCK P.M.**

Present: Mayor Arnold E. Kealy, presiding and Commissioners A.A. McKay
Jordan and A.R. Steacey.

The Minutes of the last Quarterly Meeting of the Board were read and adopted.

Application for renewal of Hotel Licenses were received from P. Larson, Hotel North Vancouver, and L. Reda, Palace Hotel. The Board unanimously granted a renewal of both these licences from 1st January next to 31st December 1908 under the usual provisions of the Statute in that behalf.

A letter dated 21st October last, was ready from Wells Brothers stating that they wished to apply for a Shop Licence in North Vancouver. As the necessary Petitions, Plans, etc. were not forthcoming with this application, the Board decided to take no action in regard thereto.

A letter was submitted and read from C.R. Hickman, giving notice that, at the Meeting of the Board to be held in March 1908, he intended to apply for a Licence to sell bottled liquors in the premises known as the Middle Store of the Kilroy Morgan Block on Lonsdale Avenue, between First and Second Streets.

The Board then took up consideration of the letter received and submitted at their last meeting from Mr. L. Reda in reference to the action taken re gambling in the Palace Hotel on 1st July.

After due consideration of all the circumstances attending the same, the Board unanimously decided to rescind its former resolution, thereby rendering void and null the black mark previously recorded against Mr. Reda's License.
