## MINUTES OF MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED AS A COURT OF RVISION HELD WITHIN THE CITY HALL ON MONDAY THE 7<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MAY 1908 AT 7:30 O'CLOCK P.M.

Present: Acting Mayor Irwin, presiding and all the Aldermen present.

The Council convened as a Court of Revision on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Local Improvement - the clearing, grading and boulevarding of Third Street from Mahon to St. David's Avenues, also laying of 6' Sidewalk on South side thereof. Several of the property owners interested were present and raised objections on the following grounds:

- 1. That it was considered the City did not propose to bear its proportionate share of the cost of the improvement.
- 2. That no reductions had been made for improvements carried out previously by property owners at their own expense.
- 3. That the time proposed in which to repay the cost of the whole improvement was considered too short.

The City Engineer was instructed to investigate and report on the first two points and to arrange separate Forms of Contract for the construction of the sidewalk and roadway, the former to be assessed for and repayable in five years and the latter twenty years.

On motion of Alderman Irwin and Alderman Braim the Court adjourned until Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> next at 8 o'clock p.m.
