

MINUTE OF STATED MEETING OF COUNCIL, ASSEMBLED AS A COURT OF REVISION, HELD IN THE CITY HALL, ON THURSDAY THE 28TH DAY OF MAY 1908, AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

The Mayor presiding and all the Aldermen present.

Third Street Local Improvement - Supplementary Report from City Engineer giving detailed statement of rebate proposed to be allowed respective property owners for improvements already carried out in front of their properties, in respect of which he recommended an additional rate of 2 ½ cents per foot. The Improvement he divided into two contracts, one for the sidewalks costing \$1,560, with a life of five years - and one for roadways costing \$10,440. with a life of ten years.

Several Owners interested considered Engineer's estimate of value of work done too low and Estimate of City's proportion, viz: \$250. much too low.

On motion of Alderman Braim and Alderman Wheeler, Engineer's Report referred back to Board of Works Committee and City Engineer for final adjustment.

A Claim by the School Trustees that School Property be exempt from taxation was sustained.
