## MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE CITY HALL ON FRIDAY THE 6th DAY OF NOVEMBER 1908 AT 5:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

The Mayor presiding and all the Aldermen present excepting Alderman Braim.

Previous to convening in the City Hall the Council met at 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and examined the conditions as existing, after which it was resolved that City Engineer Loutet be asked to hand in his resignation at an early date, and that the Mayor forward a copy of this Resolution to him.

It was further resolved that this Council approach the District Council with a view to some arrangement being made whereby the City Council may obtain the services of District Engineer Cameron as consulting Engineer for the City in the matter of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street Contract at such salary as may be agreed upon between the City and Mr. Cameron.

It was also resolved that the Contractors for 3<sup>rd</sup> Street sidewalk be asked to discontinue the work until such time as proper grades are arranged.
