

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE CITY HALL ON SATURDAY THE 7th DAY OF NOVEMBER 1908 AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

Present: His Worship Mayor Kealy, presiding, Alderman Irwin, Alderman May and Alderman Smith.

A Communication was read from Alex Philip, C.M.C. intimating that the District Council had consented to the City Council obtaining the services of District engineer Cameron as consulting Engineer for the City in the matter of 3rd Street Contract, but that Mr. Cameron, did not wish to undertake the work. Received and filed.

Bylaw No. 50 - A Bylaw to repeal Bylaw No. 49 of the City was introduced, read a first, second and third time and passed by the Council.

Bylaw No. 51 was considered and finally adopted by the Council, and the Mayor and Clerk were authorized to sign the Bylaw and the Clerk to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.

Bylaw No. 52 was also reconsidered and finally adopted by the Council, and authorized to be signed and sealed as above.

The Council thereafter adjourned to meet again on Thursday, 12th inst at 8 o'clock p.m.
