MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, ON TUESDAY THE 11TH DAY OF MAY 1909 AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

His Worship Mayor May presiding and all the Aldermen present.

A Letter received from Alderman Braim desiring to withdraw his request to resign, was read to the Meeting. On motion of Alderman Dick seconded by Alderman Young, resolved that request be accepted, and that the thanks of the Council be tendered to Alderman Braim for his courtesy in reconsidering his desire in the matter.

The Council then went into Committee and proceed to consider the financial estimates for the current year, after which Alderman McRae gave notice that at next Meeting (Regular) of the Council he would introduce the Revenue Bylaw for the year 1909; also the Mayor and Aldermen's Indemnity Bylaw.

A Letter was read from the City Solicitors stating that they were of the opinion that the Council could apply the general funds of the City for the purpose of taking a vote of the Electors by way of plebescite on the question of Sunday Baseball Playing in North Vancouver City Limits.

On motion of Alderman Dick seconded by Alderman Young resolved that a Public Meeting of Ratepayers be held in Larson's Pavilion, Esplanade, on Monday, 17th inst., at 8 o'clock p.m. to determine whether a vote of the Electors, by way of Plebescite should be taken, on the question of Sunday Baseball Playing in North Vancouver.
