MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON FRIDAY, THE $10^{\rm TH}$ DAY OF DECEMBER, 1909 AT 8 O'CLOCK, P.M.

His Worship Mayor May presiding and all the Aldermen present.

The Council met and conferred with A.G. Perry, representing the B.C. Electric Railway Co. and Messrs. Grant and Laing representing the Company's Contractors for the Lynn Valley tramline extension in reference to the lowering of the City's water main at Hastings Creek. The Contractors were unable to furnish any definite information as to the extent of work required to be done, however it was ultimately agreed that the work should be undertaken by the City and completed according to plans and profiles to be furnished the City Engineer, the work to be carried out under the direct supervision of the Water works Foreman of the City and a number of the Contractors men to be employed on the job.
