

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM ON FRIDAY THE 14th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1909 AT 5 O'CLOCK, P.M.

Present: His Worship Mayor May, presiding, Alderman Young, Alderman McNeish, Alderman McRae and Alderman Dick.

The Engineer submitted and read a Report on the dangerous condition of the Lynn Valley water main notifying Council that if the B.C.E. Railway Company proceed with their intended work, damage will be caused to the City's main.

It was moved by Alderman McNeish and seconded by Alderman McRae, that the City Solicitor be instructed to immediately place an injunction on the B.C.E. Railway Co. and their Contractors and Employees restraining them from in any way interfering with or injuring or damaging the City's water main either within the City Limits or without, along Lynn Valley Road. The City Engineer to furnish the City Solicitor with all necessary information.

The motion on being put carried unanimously.
