Messrs. James Hastie, G. Springling and J.M. Stanford, Engineer, representing the B.C. Gas Construction Syndicate, met with the Council and submitted their proposition for the establishment of a Gas Plan in the City.

The proposition which was in the form of a Bylaw was read through Clause by Clause, and amendments and additions thereto were agreed upon between the Council and the Parties, after which on motion of Alderman McNeish a Committee, consisting of Alderman Irwin, Alderman Smith and Alderman Schultz was appointed to inquire into the Council's position with the North Vancouver, Light Heat and Gas Power Co.; and to submit the present Company's proposition to the City Solicitor or some other Counsel for adjustment, and report back to the Council in Committee of the whole.
