Consideration of these Estimates by the Council was deferred until next meeting.

On motion of Alderman Irwin seconded by Alderman Smith it was resolved that Mr. Reid of the firm of Bowser Reid and Wallbridge be instructed to demand from the District Council the conveyances carrying out the provisions of the Incorporation Acts.

On motion of Alderman Schultz seconded by Alderman Smith the Clerk was instructed to ask the School Trustees to inform the Scholars that if they are found interfering with the shrubs and flowers on the Grand Boulevard or Parks in the City they will be punished.

On motion of Alderman Smith seconded by Alderman McNeish the Board of Works was instructed to have proper notice boards erected on the Grand Boulevard and Parks to protect the shrubs and flowers being interfered with by the Public.

On motion of Alderman Irwin, His Worship, The Mayor and the Chairman of the Board of Works Committee were appointed a Committee to receive the Engineers engaged to report on grades.
