MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL, HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON MONDAY THE 13th DAY OF FEBRUARY 1911 AT 8 O'CLOCK P.M.

His Worship Mayor McNeish presiding and all the Aldermen present excepting Alderman McRae.

The recommendation of the Water Committee that the Tenders of Evans, Coleman & Evans be accepted for supplying cast iron pipe was read to the meeting. After hearing representative of Evans, Coleman & Evans regarding delivery and the City Engineer who urged prompt delivery of the pipe so as to ensure Lonsdale Avenue improvement being proceeded with and completed this season. Alderman Dick moved that the contract be awarded to Evans, Coleman & Evans provided the standard 10" pipe and as much of the other as possible is shipped with the steamer sailing from the old country on the 27th instant and that the entire shipment arrives here not later than June 16th.

The motion was seconded by Alderman Kittson and agreed to.
