

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON WEDNESDAY THE 19th DAY OF APRIL 1911 AT 8 O’CLOCK P.M.

An apology for unavoidable absence was intimated from Alderman Biss.

Those members of the Council present in company with Alderman McRae and City Engineer Hanes had previous to convening made a tour of inspection of the City with a view of arriving at a definite decision regarding the extent and nature of local improvement and other public works to be undertaken this year, and the amount of bonds proposed to be issued for sale by the City’s financial agents, Messrs. Armilius Jarvis & Co.
