

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD
WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON THURSDAY THE 18th DAY OF MAY
1911 AT 8 O'CLOCK P.M.**

Alderman Biss reported that estimated cost of fence to enclose cemetery was in the neighborhood of \$250.00.

On motion of Alderman Dick seconded by Alderman Smith, the Committee's report of the 12th instant was adopted and the Committee authorized to go ahead with the erecting of the fence.

Alderman Dick reported that Councilor Bridgeman of the District Council had expressed surprise at the action taken by City Council in reference to agreement respecting dam site. It was not the intention of the District Council to have anything regarding Lynn Valley Road mentioned in the Agreement.

Alderman Dick moved that the District Council be informed that the agreement forwarded to us by their Solicitor is not satisfactory and covers ground we had no intention of including in the agreement and that they be asked to consider a proposed form of agreement which City will submit to them dealing entirely with the Intake and Road allowance. This was agreed to by the Council.

Alderman Dick submitted list of parties in arrears with water rates at 31st March last varying from \$3.00 to \$37.00.

Alderman Dick moved that the parties be informed that if payment of arrears is not made within two weeks time that water will be shut off, and that water works department be given instructions to see that this is done.

The motion was seconded by Alderman Smith and agreed to.
