

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD
WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON THURSDAY THE 3rd DAY OF AUGUST
1911 AT 9:30 O'CLOCK P.M.**

On motion of Alderman Biss seconded by Alderman Smith resolved that recommendation of Board of Works Committee to proceed with the grading of Lonsdale Avenue from Upper Keith Road to the City Limits by day labor be adopted.

Applications received for the position of Assessor for the year 1912 were referred to Alderman McRae Alderman Dick and Alderman Smith for report Monday evening.

Alderman Biss made inquiry regarding rock crusher.
The Engineer reported that the machine had not been tested since it was refitted. Alderman Henderson moved that Mussels Limited be asked to supply a skilled mechanic to put the machine to a test for at least one week at manufacturer's expense in view of the fact that machine was defective when supplied to the City. The motion was seconded by Alderman Smith and agreed to.

The Board of Works Committee was empowered to engage an expert in rock crushing to witness and report on the test to the Council.
