

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON SATURDAY THE 30th DAY OF DECEMBER 1911 AT 1:45 O'CLOCK P.M.

Reports and recommendations by the Finance, Health, Police, Board of Works, Local Improvement, Waterworks, Fire and Light and Parks Committees on due accounts were submitted to the Meeting by the Chairman of the respective Committees and the Treasurer was authorized to pay the accounts to the amounts following:

On motion of Alderman McRae seconded by Alderman Biss it was resolved to reserve to the City a road allowance 66' in width on the south side of Mahon Park extending from Forbes Avenue to Delbruck Avenue, such road allowance to be vested in the Corporation.

Alderman Smith gave in a report regarding Hospital accounts. There appeared to be a deficit balance of \$64.44 on 27th December which would have to be met by the City and District. Alderman Smith was requested to have the account brought down to the end of the year.

Alderman Biss inquired of Alderman Smith as Chairman of the Fire & Light Committee if he was aware that one of the horses in the Fire team at No. 2 Hall was a balky horse. Alderman Smith said he had been informed by the Fire Chief that one of the horses while out exercising on 17th Street had refused to go on account of the soft nature of the street, however, he said he would make further inquiry and report.
