MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON THURSDAY THE 11TH OF APRIL 1912.

After consulting with the City Solicitor Reid who was in attendance, Alderman Dick moved the following resolution which was seconded by Alderman Biss and carried unanimously:

WHEREAS it has been called to the attention of the Council that the Tender of Contractor H.V. tucker dated 20th February 1912 for the supply of rock contains two columns of figures, one under the head of "price per cu. yd." giving various prices for the supply of rock to the various streets therein set out and the other headed, "total price for approximate quantities mentioned," purporting to fix the cost of said rock for each local improvement scheme therein set out.

AND WHEREAS the offer accepted for the supply of rock was for 33,900 cu. yds. of rock at the price of \$2.63 1/3 per cu. yd. no matter on which of said streets such rock was to be delivered.

NOW THEREFORE it is declared that such distribution was not authorized or accepted by the Council or by anyone under its direction nor was the same approved by it; and the Council directs that the amount to be charged to each street for rock supplied thereon is to be at the rate of \$2.63 1/3 cu. yd. for each cu. yd. supplied on each of such streets according to the offer made by said H.V. Tucker and accepted by the Council.
