

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD
WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON MONDAY THE 25TH DAY OF APRIL
1912 AT 8 O'CLOCK P.M.**

After considering with Mr. J.C. Williams the question of 4th Street widening the Council unanimously resolved in the affirmative to accept the City Engineer's local improvement report on 4th Street widening. On motion of Alderman Fraser seconded by Alderman Foreman the Engineer was instructed to furnish Mr. Williams with a grade for building at the northwest corner of 4th Street and Lonsdale Avenue assuming the street to be 100' wide.

The City Engineer was instructed to get prices of 6" pipe from Messrs. Evans, Coleman & Evans and report at next meeting.

A recommendation by the Fire Committee that Mr. W. Massey be paid \$25.00 for expert services was accepted by the Council.

The Waterworks Committee recommended the acceptance of Messrs. Evans, Coleman & Evans tender for 5000 lin. ft. 16" lap welded steel pipe at the price of \$9150. The recommendation was accepted by the Council.

Mayor McNeish intimated that he had accepted the resignation of Alderman McRae as a member of the Finance Committee and appointed Alderman Irwin as Chairman of the Committee in place of Alderman McRae resigned.

City Clerk Shepherd intimated his desire to resign office as Clerk of the Council.

Alderman Dick moved that Council adjourn. The motion was seconded by Alderman Fraser and Council stood adjourned.
