

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD

The report of the Board of Works Committee as contained in the Committee's minutes of this date was read and on motion adopted.

The report of the Waterworks Committee as contained in the Committee's minutes of this date was also read and on motion approved.

The Mayor was authorized to obtain the Solicitor's opinion as to the signatures on 4th Street widening petition.

The Clerk was authorized to verify the signatures and the Engineer to return a revised estimate of the cost.

On motion of Alderman Dick seconded by Alderman Biss it was resolved that it is the sense of this Council that Lonsdale Avenue be paved with a permanent pavement of suitable material to the north line of First Street and that with this purpose in view prices of different materials be obtained.

Thos present went through the several applications received for the position of City Engineer and decided to recommend to the Council on Monday evening next that Mr. Angus Smith, City Engineer of Victoria be appointed City Engineer of North Vancouver at a salary of \$350.00 per month.

A letter was read from the National Surety Corporation authorizing the Council to pay estimates on the rock contract to Messrs. Howes Proctor & Company. It was resolved that the Messrs. Howes, Proctor & Co. be paid the amount due them less wages and that so soon as they present receipted payroll for wages that they be paid the amount.
