

**MINUTES OF MEETING OF COURT OF REVISION HELD IN THE CITY HALL
ON TUESDAY THE 21st DAY OF MAY 1912 AT 10:00 A.M.**

The following appeals were heard against assessments for works of Local Improvement:

For grading St. George's Avenue from 8th to 19th streets.

From Catherine E. Keene appealing against the subdivision of her property the frontage of which was 680' on St. George's Avenue. Court ordered that Assessment should be for full frontage instead of being divided as appearing in the Schedule.

For grading 13th street.

From E.R. Follic complaining against his being assessed for 60' instead of 30'. It was found that Acorn was assessed for 30' E ½ and Follick 30' W ½. Court ordered a division of the Assessment.

From F.B. Cudney appealing against being assessed for 2488 easterly portion of Block 75 in place of 182'. It was learned that some other party owned 66' of this subdivision and the Court ordered the necessary changes.

From North Vancouver Land & Improvement company appealing against their being assessed for various properties which they had transferred to other parties and in the matter of filling in foreshore in front of Fell and Bewicke Avenues being assessed for the lane in Block 67 which was dedicated to the public and for the lane in Block 53, which was also dedicated to the public. The Court ordered that the necessary changes be made in the names of the owners and that the assessment against the lanes in question should be charged to the City.

Bylaw No. 210, being a "Bylaw to consolidate the Debentures authorized to be issued by the above Bylaws, amounting in all to \$172,820" was introduced, read a first, second and third time and passed by the Council.

The Board of Works were authorized to proceed with the relaying of the old sidewalk on the west side of Lonsdale Avenue from first Street north and to repair where necessary.
