The Committee unanimously resolved to recommend that the sum of \$250 be paid to Mr. Shepherd as a return for extra work performed by him during his tenure of the position of City Clerk and also that Mr. Shepherd be asked to give his services to the end of the present month.

The Treasurer was instructed to charge hospital fees to such of the Civic employees as have petitioned for same at the rate of \$1.00 per month. All sums collected on this account to be handed over to the Medical Health Officer.

The Sanitary inspector reported that the Proprietors of certain houses on 2nd Street refused or at all events delayed to make connections between their houses and the sewer. The Clerk was instructed to write Mr. Crawford the Agent for those houses that unless the connection was made within 14 days the Board would proceed to make connections and would take steps to obtain a refund of the cost of same from the Proprietors.
