A telegram was read from the Military Secretary of the Governor General in the following terms:

"Their Royal Highnesses very gladly accept invitation visit North Vancouver afternoon, September twentieth about three thirty. Send best thanks invitation Luncheon with regret unable accept."

The Mayor was appointed a Committee to make any arrangements necessary in regard to the visit of His Royal Highness.

A letter was read for the City Solicitor stating that his firm has been asked to accept service of a notice of arbitration in the matter of arbitration between Colin F. Jackson and the City respecting damage to Lots 19, 20/25/273, and also stating that if damage has been done a tender should be made. Referred to the Mayor and Engineer to examine the premises alleged to have been damaged and thereafter to see the City Solicitor at the same time denying liability for any such damage. Resolved that same procedure be followed in the case of Loutet against the City.

Plans of resubdivision of Lots 7 & 8/9/273 and of Lot 14/7/616 were laid before the meeting and approved.

Plan of proposed subdivision of Block 1/616 was submitted to the meeting and the City Engineer was instructed to examine the ground and report to the Council.

A Recommendation of the Board of Works that tenders be called for cement sidewalk on Lonsdale Avenue was adopted and the City Engineer was instructed to call fore same.
