

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD
THURSDAY, JULY 18th, 1912.**

A recommendation from the Board of Works that the B.C. Electric Railway Co. be given facilities for unloading tram rails at the Chesterfield avenue wharf on condition that they pay the usual wharfage charges was laid before the meeting and agreed to.

A recommendation of the Board of Works that as requested by the B.C. Electric Railway Co., the City Engineer be instructed to give the necessary grade and location stakes for the track on 1st Street and also that the steps to dispose of the water lying on the north side of that street in the vicinity of Semisch Avenue was laid before the meeting and adopted.

Council then went into Committee of the Whole and the question of the various lanes within the City limits was taken up.

Alderman Irwin gave the history of the lanes in D.L. 274 and after discussion on this and on the question of lanes throughout the City in the course of which suggestions were made that a map of all the lanes belonging to the City should be prepared and that to this end a lawyer should be engaged to make the necessary searches, the matter was left in the hands of the Lanes Committee.
