MINUTES OF ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 26th, 1912 AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

Council resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.

Alderman Dick explained that the difficulties which had been experienced in collecting water rates form the campers and stated that cases had been discovered where water rates had been collected by third parties and had not been accounted for to the city.

Resolved that the Chief of Police be instructed to issue summons against two of the parties who have collected water rates as above and retained the amount collected. The Chief of police to take instructions from the Treasurer as to what parties are to be summoned.

Resolved that notices be posted on the south side of the Esplanade showing the necessity for the payment of water rates by campers and stating that in failure to do so water will be cut off.

Resolved that the Waterworks Bylaw be amended to the effect that after the beginning of the year all outside taps at present used by campers will be removed and that all applications for water thereafter must be signed by the owner of the property and will only be granted on the understanding that the taps are placed inside the camps.

Resolved also that the rate for such taps be \$9.00 per annum.
