

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD  
WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON THURSDAY, MAY 29TH, 1913 AT  
8 O'CLOCK P.M.**

A letter was produced from Macdonalds Limited asking for letter press copy and photographs of N.V. City as soon as possible, in connection with their forthcoming production "Along the Imperial Highway".

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Wheeler and resolved that it be left to the Mayor, Finance Committee and the City Clerk to prepare information and obtain the photographs necessary.

With regard to the question of new premises to be used as a City Hall it was moved by Alderman Kennedy seconded by Alderman Wheeler and resolved that the City Engineer measure up the various premises offered to the City and report. The Clerk was instructed to discover what charge will be made by the K.P. Hall Company for the use of the premises without the downstairs dining room.

With regard to the question of insurance it was moved by Alderman Kennedy seconded by Alderman Pilling and resolved that the opinion of the Solicitor be obtained as to whether the Council has authority under the Municipal Act to pay premiums of insurance on employees. Moved by Alderman Wheeler seconded by Alderman Kennedy that the City do not renew their Policy of Employers Liability Insurance at the present time. The motion was put to the Meeting and carried. Alderman Williams dissenting.

Council thereafter adjourned.
