After considering the various propositions placed before the Council the Joint Meeting recommended that the offer of the upper floor of the Keith Block with the exception of Rooms 14 and 22 be accepted for Council purposes, the rent to be \$10.00 per room or \$90.00 per month in all. The use to be had of four vaults, and also that the portion of the basement at present occupied by Johnston & Salsbury be had at the rate of \$25.00 per month, and that the portion of the last mentioned basement at present unoccupied be rented from the Proprietors at the rate of \$25.00 per month for police purposes.
