

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 3rd, 1913 AT
8 O'CLOCK P.M.**

Thee being no business before the Council other than the introduction and consideration of Bylaws that order of business was referred to.

Moved by Alderman Pilling seconded by Alderman Williams and resolved that leave be now granted to introduce at this meeting of the Council a Bylaw entitled "A Bylaw to Consolidate the School and General Debentures of 1913" and that the Bylaw receive its three readings at this meeting of the Council, and that the three readings of this Bylaw be deemed an urgent one within the meaning of the Procedure Bylaw.

Whereupon the Bylaw was read a first, second and third time and passed by the Council.

Moved by Alderman Pilling seconded by Alderman Williams and resolved that the Bylaw to amend Bylaws Nos. 236, 243 and 258 be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Whereupon the Bylaw was reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Moved by Alderman Pilling seconded by Alderman Vance and resolved that the City Clerk be instructed to go to Victoria with a view of having the necessary approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council obtained in respect to the several Debenture Bylaws now requiring the attention of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

Council adjourned to convene again at 1 p.m. on Saturday 6th instant.
