

**CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER**

**ELECTION HELD JULY 18<sup>TH</sup>, 1914**

“The City of North Vancouver, Vancouver Power and Light Company’s Franchise Purchase Bylaw, 1914”

I, JOHN FREDERICK COLLINS, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver, B.C., do hereby certify that as directed by resolution of Council bearing date of July 6<sup>th</sup>, 1914, I gave notice to the Electors of the City of North Vancouver on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1914, as required by law to the effect following: that is to say, that the vote of the Electors of the said City would be taken on “The City of North Vancouver, Vancouver Power and Light Company’s franchise Purchase Bylaw, 1914”, at number 111 First Street East in the said City on Saturday, July 18<sup>th</sup>, 1914, between the hours of 9 o’clock A.M. and 7 o’clock P.M.
