

**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL
CHAMBER ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 7th
1914 AT 10:00 A.M.**

In pursuant to Notice posted on December 5th calling a Special Meeting of the Council, His Worship Mayor Irwin took the Chair on Monday, December 7th at 10 A.M.; said Meeting being for the purpose of transacting General Business.

City Treasurer Humphreys presented a draft of a trip sheet to be used in connection with the Ferry service. Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Wright and resolved that the draft trip sheet as presented by the City Treasurer be approved of and adopted and that the Treasurer have a sufficient quantity printed at once.

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Fowler and resolved that the Mates on board the Ferry boats be empowered and instructed to collect vehicle tickets until further arrangements have been made.

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Fowler and resolved that the whole Council be constituted a Special Committee to hold an Inquiry in pursuant of Sections 47 and 48 of the Municipal Act into all matters, which said Committee may consider it necessary and expedient to inquire into, relating to the administration of the City Ferries and ferry system, and that such Committee set and hold such Inquiry at the Council Chamber, City Hall, Lonsdale Avenue in the City of North Vancouver at the hour of 2:30 P.M. on Monday, the 7th day of December 1914, and that His Worship Mayor Irwin be authorized to issue under his Hand all Summonses to witnesses to give evidence upon such inquiry and have same served upon all persons whom he may deem necessary and material witnesses thereon at the time and place above mentioned.

Moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Fowler and resolved that WHEREAS it appears that certain employees of the Ferries should be suspended; THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Alderman Vance, Chairman of the Ferry Committee instruct Superintendent Heard to suspend, whom they think necessary, of the Ferry employees.

Moved by Alderman Kennedy seconded by Alderman Fowler and resolved that WHEREAS owing to certain suspensions in the Ferry service having to be made it will be necessary to temporarily fill the vacancies, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the filling of the vacancies referred to be left in the hands of Alderman Vance and Superintendent Heard.

At 10:45 it was moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Fowler and resolved that the Council adjourn.

Whereupon the Council adjourned.
