

**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 31st, 1914 AT 3:00 P.M.**

Mr. E.A.C. Gibson, Manager of The Granite Quarries, Ltd. was present and on motion of Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Fowler Mr. Gibson was given permission to address the Council.

Mr. Gibson stated that he had about concluded arrangements with the Council of the District of North Vancouver to supply crushed rock for the macadamizing of Robson Road and some other adjacent roads in the Municipality and requested that he be given permission to use a portion of the Bewicke Avenue fill for storing the rock when being unloaded from scows. He also stated that he would be in a position to sell rock to the City at a very low figure probably at 75¢ per cubic yard. Moved by Alderman Kennedy seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that this matter be referred to the incoming Council.

Reports and recommendations by the Finance, (Schools, Police,) Ferry, Board of Works, Local Improvement, Waterworks, Fire and Light, Parks and Board of Health Committees on due accounts were submitted by the respective Chairmen and read to the Meeting and the Treasurer was authorized to pay the accounts to the amounts following:
