

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 19TH, 1915 AT 4 P.M.

Pursuant to adjournment Mayor Hanes called the Meeting to Order at 4 P.M.

Mr. Bridgman was present and addressed the Council in reference to the position of the Lonsdale Estate as to the annexation of D.L. 272 and foreshore lot. After consideration by the Council it was moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Vance and resolved that a provision be inserted in the proposed Bill, now before the Legislature, entitled "The City of North Vancouver Extension of Boundaries Act 1915", to the effect that in the event of a Bylaw referred to in subsection (2) of section 3 of said proposed Bill, being submitted to the Electors and such Bylaw fails to receive the assent of the electors, such failure to receive such assent shall ipso facto nullify said Act and every matter and thing therein contained.

In pursuance to the above Resolution the Solicitor was instructed to meet Mr. Bridgman and Mr. Griffin, Solicitor for the Lonsdale Estate, and if possible, arrange an amendment to the Bill before the legislature providing that the streets on the foreshore, when improved and paid for by the City, would be conveyed to the City and a further amendment in pursuance with the above resolution.

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Wright and resolved that the Council stand adjourned till 4 P.M., Saturday, February 20th, 1915

Whereunto the Council adjourned at 6:15 P.M.
