

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD IN THE  
COMMITTEE ROOM, SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 20<sup>TH</sup>, 1915 AT 4 P.M.**

Pursuant to adjournment Mayor Hanes called the Meeting to Order at 4 P.M.

The City Solicitor stated that he had that day interviewed Mr. Bridgman and Mr. Griffin, and that they had agreed to amend the proposed Bill before the Legislature by inserting a clause providing that upon payment by the City to Fell and Lonsdale for improvements to street allowances and street ends in the foreshore, that Fell and Lonsdale would convey the street allowances and street ends to the City, and that he had submitted a further proposed amendment to the Bill to Mr. Griffin, who had taken the same under advisement and agreed to notify the Solicitor not later than the following day, if he agreed thereto.

The Solicitor was thereon instructed, in the event of receiving advice from Mr. Griffin that he approved of the Amendment, that the City Solicitor go to Victoria, Sunday night to again appear before the Private Bills Committee, and if he does not receive such advice from Mr. Griffin not to go but to allow the Bill to drop.

At 5 P.M. it was moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Biss and removed that the Council adjourn.
