

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE
COUNCIL CHAMBER ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 10th, 1915 AT 10:15 P.M.**

Moved by Alderman Foreman seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that Local Improvement debenture Bylaws Nos. 171 to 181 (both inclusive) be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal. Whereupon the several Bylaws were read and reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and the seal affixed thereto.

Moved by Alderman Biss seconded by Alderman MacDonald that the Bylaw to authorize the opening, making, improving and preserving of certain streets or roads within the City of North Vancouver be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk, sealed with the Corporate Seal and numbered 322.

Alderman Foreman stated, in speaking to the motion, that on going over the schedule of the streets where the work to be authorized is to be done, that he found practically all of the work was in outlying districts and in all probability would not be actually required for at least five years, and that he strongly objected to the Bylaw being passed at the present item.

Mr. Wm. Morden was present and on motion of Alderman Foreman seconded by Alderman Biss was granted permission to address the Council. Whereupon Mr. Morden stated that he did not approve of more money being spent on the streets at present and increasing the Tax rate and strongly objected to the Bylaw being passed.

The motion was put resulting as follows:

For the motion: Alderman Vance Alderman Biss Alderman Wright Alderman Kennedy and Alderman MacDonald

Against the motion: Alderman Foreman.

The motion was declared carried.

Whereupon the Bylaw was read and reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the mayor and clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal and numbered 322.

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that Bylaw No. 320 initialled, "The Bylaw to consolidate the sums authorized to be borrowed by certain Local Improvement Bylaws Into one sum of \$19,825" be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Whereupon the Bylaw was read and reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman MacDonald and resolved that Bylaw No.3 21 initialed "A Bylaw to consolidate the sums authorized to be borrowed by certain Local Improvement Bylaws into one sum of \$47,440" be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Whereupon the Bylaw was read and reconsidered, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

AT 11:10 it was moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that the Council adjourn.
