

**STATEMENT OF ELECTION HELD JULY 3RD, 1915 ON
“THE NORTH VANCOUVER CITY FERRIES PURCHASE LOAN BYLAW, 1915**

In the matter of an Election held on “The North Vancouver City Ferries Purchase Loan Bylaw, 1915”.

I, John Frederick Collins of the City of North Vancouver, Province of British Columbia, Clerk of the Municipal Council of said City do solemnly declare and say:

1. That by Resolution of the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of North Vancouver, I was appointed Returning Officer to take a vote of the Electors of said City on “The North Vancouver City Ferries Purchase Loan Bylaw, 1915”.
2. That I took the vote of the Electors of said City of said Bylaw on July 3rd, 1915 and the votes were counted resulting as follows:

Number of votes polled	112
For the Bylaw	100
Against the Bylaw	12

3. That the vote polled in favor of said Bylaw being at least three-fifths of the persons who voted, I forthwith declared that “The North Vancouver City Ferries Purchase Loan Bylaw, 1915” had received the assent of the Electors.

AND I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing it to be true and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the “Canada Evidence Act”.
