

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13TH, 1915 AT 8:00 P.M.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the 7th instant were taken as read and on motion of Alderman Biss seconded by Alderman Vance adopted.

Correspondence was received, read and dealt with as follows:

From City Treasurer Humphreys advising the Council that under instructions he had sold \$30,000 City of North Vancouver 6%, twenty year ferry Debentures to Messrs. Fincke, Bangert & Co. of Philadelphia at 84 ¼ plus accrued interest.

Moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that the sale of \$30,000 City of North Vancouver 6% twenty year Ferry Debentures to Fincke, Bangert & Co. at 84 ¼ plus accrued interest as made by the Treasurer of recent date, be and is hereby confirmed.

Moved by Alderman Vance seconded by Alderman Wright and resolved that the City Clerk take the Debentures to Victoria for the purpose of having them certified to by the Municipal Inspector.

Reports and recommendations by the Ferry, Board of Works, Board of Health, Waterworks and Parks Committees on due accounts were submitted by the respective Chairmen and read to the Meeting and the Treasurer was authorized to pay the accounts to the amounts following:

Moved by Alderman Foreman seconded by Alderman Kennedy and resolved that the City Clerk communicate with the several Agents of Insurance Companies who carry insurance risks on the new City Hall, pointing out to them that the risk on the building occupied as a City Hall is less than if occupied as a school in view of which the Companies be requested to allow the old premium rate to obtain instead of increasing.

Moved by Alderman MacDonald seconded by Alderman Wright and resolved that the Council Chamber be rewired so that four lights will be installed instead of two as at Present and that the same be left in the hands of the Chief of Police to complete.

At 8:10 it was moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Vance and resolved that the Council adjourns to convene again at 8 P.M. September 16th.
