## MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 18<sup>th</sup>, 1916 AT 4:00 P.M.

Pursuant to notice His Worship Mayor Hanes called the Meeting to order and stated to the Aldermen that the object f the Meeting was for the purpose of considering the estimates of expenditures of the several standing committees for the current year.

The several standing committees submitted estimates of their requirements for the year as follows:

Board of Health	6,000
Parks & Boulevard Committee	3,900
Police Committee	12,000

Mr. J.F. Helliwell on behalf of the Bank of British North America was present and the financial position of the City and its requirements for the year were discussed and Mr. Helliwell suggested that an application be made to the Bank of British North America for an advance of money sufficient to finance the City to March 31<sup>st</sup> and also stated that in his opinion it would be well to advise the Bank of what the Council is doing in respect to legislation giving a Municipality power to borrow money against arrears of taxes.

Moved by Alderman Foreman seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that the clerk on behalf o the City of North Vancouver make application to the Bank of British North America for an advance of \$55,000 in addition to the \$21,000 already advanced as a temporary loan to meet the current legal expenses of the City to March 31<sup>st</sup>, and that the Bank be advised that the City through the Union of British Columbia Municipalities is endeavoring to obtain legislative authority to borrow money against arrears of taxes.

At 5:05 it was moved by Alderman Foreman seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the council adjourn.
