

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED COUNCIL MEETING HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, THURSDAY, APRIL 13th, 1916 AT 9:45 P.M.

Pursuant to adjournment the Mayor called the Council to order.

The matter of paying Debenture interest to the amount of \$4500 due on the 15th instant was discussed.

Moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Foreman and resolved that the Royal Bank of Canada be asked to advance to the City the sum of \$1700.00 as a temporary loan on the City's Promissory Note, said Note to be signed by the Mayor, Finance Committee and City Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal.

Moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that failing to receive the advance of \$1700.00 as a temporary loan from the Royal Bank for the purpose of paying Debenture interest due on the 15th instant that the said amount be taken temporarily from the Road Machinery Purchase Bylaw fund and that the mayor and Treasurer be and are hereby authorized to draw a cheque for the amount on said account and that the money be returned to the Road Machinery Purchase Bylaw account as soon as possible.

At 10:15 Alderman Foreman seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that the Council adjourn.
