

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE COUNCIL, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER ON MONDAY, JULY 11TH, 1916 AT 3:00 P.M.

Mr. Sperry General Manager of the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Co. was present and a Delegation from the North Vancouver Board of Trade.
A letter was received and read from Mr. Sperry being a request that the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Co. be given a lease of a portion of Chesterfield Avenue Street End for the purpose of establishing a car ferry service.

After considerable discussion it was moved by Alderman Wright and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that the lease of Chesterfield avenue Street End with the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Co. which expired in November 1915, be continued in force for a period of five years from date of expiration and that these together with the City Clerk redraw the Agreement.

At 4:30 P.M. it was moved by Alderman Wright seconded by Alderman Morden and resolved that the Council adjourn to convene again on Thursday July 13th, 1916 at 7 P.M.
