

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE COUNCIL, HELD SEPTEMBER 21st,
1916 AT 8:00 P.M., IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL,**

Pursuant to adjournment the Mayor called the meeting to order at 8:30.

Moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that the salary to be paid the person appointed as Treasurer of the City of North Vancouver be set at \$125.00 per month.

Moved by Alderman Morden seconded by Alderman Foreman and resolved that the salary to be paid the person appointed Collector of the Corporation of the City of North Vancouver be set at \$125.00 per month.

Moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that one person be appointed as Assistant to the Collector of the Corporation of the City of North Vancouver.

Moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the salary to be paid the person appointed as Assistant to the Collector be set at \$75.00 per month.

Moved by Alderman Wright and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that all receipts issued by the City contain an notation thereon as to whether the amount paid has been paid by check or cash.

Moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that a ballot be taken on the applications received for the purpose of selecting one as Treasurer of the City. Whereupon the ballot was spread resulting as follows:

George C.R. Lane - 3

George E. Kyle - 2

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Morden and resolved that Mr. C.R. Lane be and he is hereby appointed Treasurer of the City of North Vancouver during the pleasure of the Council at a salary of \$125.00 per month, he to assume such duties as soon as possible but not later than October 1st, 1916.

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Foreman and resolved that a ballot be taken on the applications received for the purpose of selecting a person to fill the position of Collector of the City of North Vancouver. Whereupon a ballot was spread resulting as follows:

George E. Kyle 5

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Foreman and resolved that George E. Kyle be and he is hereby appointed Collector of the Corporation of the City of

North Vancouver during the pleasure of the Council, at a salary of \$125.00 per month, he to assume his duties as soon as possible but not later than October 1st, 1916.

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Wright and resolved that Mr. Kyle recommend to the Council the name of some person from amongst the applications received whom he desired to see appointed as his assistant and report to the Council on Monday September 25th, 1916.

At 10:30 it was moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that the Council adjourn.
