

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF THE COUNCIL, HELD SEPTEMBER 28<sup>TH</sup>,  
1916 AT 8:30 P.M.**

Owing to the absence of Mayor Hanes, City Clerk, J.F. Collins, called the Council to order at 8:30 P.M.

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that Alderman Barclay act as Chairman of the meeting for the evening. Whereupon Alderman Barclay took the chair.

Mr. Lamberton, City Auditor was present. The Chairman explained to Mr. Lamberton that the Council had come to the conclusion that they desired to have another auditor and intimated to Mr. Lamberton that it was the desire of the Council that he hand in his resignation. Mr. Lamberton replied that he did not intend to resign.

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Biss and resolved that Mr. W.C. Lamberton, City Auditor be notified that his services as auditor for the City of North Vancouver will not be required after October 31<sup>st</sup>, 1916.

Moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the City Clerk instruct Mr. Humphreys to turn over to Mr. G.R. Lane, sometime between the hours of 9 A.M. and 12 noon, Saturday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 1916 all of the books, keys, documents, papers, etc. in his custody, being the property of the City. Also to turn over to Mr. Lane what cash he might have on hand at that time and to also communicate to Mr. Lane the combination of numbers and arrangement of Sam used by him, being required to open the City Vaults and inside safe used by his Department.

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Foreman and resolved that Mr. Fletcher of the Norris Safe & Lock Company be requested to be at the City Hall Saturday afternoon at 3:30 P.M. for the purpose of assisting in the changing of the combination of the Treasurer's vault and safe.

At 9:25 it was moved by Alderman Foreman and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the Council adjourn.
