

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED COUNCIL MEETING HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, MARCH 22ND, 1917 AT 7:30 P.M.

The matter of the appointment of a City Clerk to succeed the present City Clerk, Mr. J.F. Collins, resigned, was at once taken up.

A ballot was taken resulting in the list of 36 applicants being cut down to a choice of 13. Moved by Alderman Clark and seconded by Alderman McBain that the Council proceed to take a second ballot and that each Alderman be permitted to vote for six candidates or less, to be chosen from the thirteen remaining candidates.

The following amendment was offered:

Moved by Alderman Morden and seconded by Alderman McBain that the references of the eight experienced candidates out of the thirteen chosen on the first ballot be read.

The amendment was put and declared lost.

The motion was then put and declared carried.

Whereupon a second ballot was taken resulting in the same thirteen being selected.

Whereupon the testimonials of all of the thirteen candidates was read.

Moved by Alderman Barclay and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the salary to be paid the City Clerk about to be appointed be set at \$125.00 per month.

Moved by Alderman Barclay and seconded by Alderman McBain and resolved that a third ballot on the candidates be now taken and that each Alderman be permitted to vote for three candidates as a first, second and third choice.

Whereupon the ballot was spread resulting with six candidates being selected.

A subsequent or fourth ballot was also taken resulting in five of the candidates remaining.

Whereupon it was moved by Alderman Barclay and seconded by Alderman Clark and resolved that the Council do now ballot finally for one candidate to be appointed as City Clerk. Whereupon the ballot was spread resulting as follows:

R.F. Archibald - 4

George E. Kyle - 3

Moved by Alderman Morden and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that Rupert F. Archibald be and he is hereby appointed City Clerk of the City of North Vancouver as and from April 15th, 1917, during the pleasure of the Council.

At 9:15 it was moved by Alderman Clark and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that he Council adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
