

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD WITHIN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, THURSDAY, JULY 12<sup>TH</sup>, 1917 AT 8:30 P.M.**

Mr. A.R. Clucas, Acting City Engineer, submitted a recommendation that the tender of Mr. John E. Sultan for painting the City Hall and Janitor's residence be accepted. Moved by Alderman Wright and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that the tender of Mr. John E. Sultan for painting the City Hall and Janitor's residence for the price of \$573.00 be and is hereby accepted.

The following correspondence as dealt with:

From Edit M. Southcott, Assistant Secretary Women's Canadian Club, Vancouver, requests permission to hold a Tag Day on the Ferries on July 21<sup>st</sup>. Moved by Alderman Barclay and seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the above request of Miss E.M. Southcott, be granted.

From the Minister of Trade & Commerce in reply to a letter from this Council requesting that the jurisdiction of the Fuel Controller be extended to the Pacific Coast, stating that this has been done and the activities of the Fuel Controller will be applied to the whole of Canada. Ordered filed.

From C.A. Magrath, Fuel Controller of Canada, stating that he had gotten in touch with the Premier of B.C. and trusting that a settlement as the result of the investigation being carried on by Mr. Sloan at Victoria, would be reached at an early date. Moved by Alderman Wright and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that letter from Mr. C.A. Magrath Fuel Controller be acknowledged and that he be advised that if he is unable at the present time to visit the coast that this Council think its advisable that he acquaint himself thoroughly with the position of matter on the Coast.

From Charles Germyn, stating that while taking out shingle bolts from D.L. 856 and 857, a certain amount of wood would have to be cut in order to make roads and offering 25 cents per cord for the same or a lump sum of \$100.00. Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that in the above letter from C. Germyn be referred to the Engineer to report on Monday night.

Moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that a resolution passed by the Council on August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1915, in respect to the dismissal of all unmarried men in the employ of the City, and that only married men be engaged hereafter be rescinded.

At 9:30 it was moved by Alderman Irwin and seconded by Alderman McBain and resolved that the Council adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned
