

CERTIFICATE OF RETURNING OFFICER

Result of Municipal Election held on January 14th and 17th, 1918

I, RUPERT FOSTER ARCHIBALD, Returning Officer for the City of North Vancouver do hereby certify that as directed by Statute I gave notice to the Electors of the City of North Vancouver on the 4th day of January 1918, as required by law, to the effect that nominations for the Election of persons to represent the said Electors, in the Municipal Council as Mayor and Aldermen and the Election of two(2) persons to represent them as School Trustees, for two years, and the election of two (2) persons to represent them as Police Commissioners, would be received by me at any time between the date of the Notice and 2 o'clock p.m., Monday, January 14th, 1918, and that at the expiration of the time appointed for the nomination of Candidates as aforesaid, no more Candidates stood nominated than there were vacancies to be filled, for the office of Mayor.

I forthwith declared GEORGE WASHINGTON VANCE duly elected as Mayor for the City of North Vancouver for the ensuing year.

There being no more nominations of Candidates for the office of School Trustees than there were vacancies to be filled, I forthwith declared DUGALD HENDERSON McCOLL and MARCUS SERVIUS McDOWELL, duly elected as School Trustees for two years.

There being more nominations of Candidates as aforesaid in the case of Aldermen and Police Commissioners, then there were vacancies to be filled, a Poll became necessary and such poll was granted by me and opened at 116 Esplanade West, on Thursday, January 17th, 1918, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m. and that after the closing of the Poll the votes were counted, resulting as follows:

And that I forthwith declared George Albert McBain; Thomas Irwin; Bruce Watson; Thomas Robert Clark; Edwy Allan Morden; and William Jack Barclay, duly elected as Aldermen, and Charles Edgar Johnston elected Police Commissioner for two years and John Bermister Pain elected Police Commissioner for one year.

As directed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Vancouver for the year 1917, I caused certified copies of Bylaws entitled, "The William Lyall Shipbuilding Company Limited Exemption Bylaw" to be published and posted as required by law together with notices appended thereto, that the said Bylaws would be submitted for a vote of the assent of the Electors at No. 116 Esplande West, on Thursday, January 17th, 1918 between the hours of 9 o'clock A.M. and 7 o'clock P.M., and that the said vote of the Electors was taken on the said day resulting as follows:

For the Bylaw	321

The vote polled in favor of the above mentioned Bylaw being at least three-fifths of the persons who voted on said Bylaw I declared the said Bylaw as having duly received the assent of the Electors.

As directed by the Municipal Council of the City of North Vancouver for the year 1917, I cause a Notice to be published and posted to the effect that the opinion of the electros of said City, would be taken upon the question:

"Are you in favor of the City Council, granting to the City Firemen, their request for one day's leave in every four, instead of one in seven as at present".

The vote resulted as follows:
