

MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 27TH, 1918.

Pursuant to adjournment, the Mayor called the meeting to order.

The regular order of business was dispensed with and consideration of Bylaws proceeded with.

Moved by Alderman McBain seconded by Alderman Barclay and resolved that leave be now granted to introduce at this meeting of the Council a Bylaw entitled "City of North Vancouver General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes Bylaw, 1918" and that the said Bylaw receive its three several readings at this meeting of the Council, and that the occasion for said three readings be deemed an urgent one within the meaning of the Procedure Bylaw. Whereupon the Bylaw was introduced and read the first time.

Moved by Alderman Irwin seconded by Alderman McBain and resolved that the Bylaw entitled "City of North Vancouver General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes Bylaw, 1918" be now read a second time. Whereupon the Bylaw was read the second time.

Moved by Alderman Barclay seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the Committee proceedings in respect to "City of North Vancouver General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes Bylaw, 1918" be dispensed with.

Moved by Alderman Barclay seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the Bylaw entitled "City of North Vancouver General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes Bylaw, 1918" be now read a third time. Whereupon the Bylaw was read the third time and passed by the Council.

Mayor Vance reported having received a telegram from Mr. A. Wallace, having reference to a report which appeared in the "Daily Province" of February 26th. The telegram stated that orders had been given to stop work on No. 2 Ferry. Mayor Vance also stated that Mr. Heard had advised him on the telephone that the repair work on No. 2 Ferry boat had been stopped.

Moved by Alderman Irwin seconded by Alderman McBain and resolved that the Ferry Committee be appointed a Special Committee to take up the above matter with the Wallace shipyards and place the proceedings of Council of February 25th in a proper light before the Wallace Shipyards.

Moved by Alderman Barclay seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the council adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
