Moved by Alderman Barclay seconded by Alderman Watson and resolved that the necessary arrangements be made to bond the Bookkeeper and Stenographer in the amount of \$5000.00.

Alderman Barclay, Chairman of the Ferry committee, reported verbally that Mr. Edmond, Ferry Superintendent, is prepared to withdraw his resignation, and Alderman Irwin requested that the Superintendent do so in writing.

Moved by Alderman Clark seconded by Alderman Morden and resolved that the Council do now adjourn.
