

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, TUESDAY, JANUARY 14<sup>TH</sup>, 1919, AT 7:00 P.M.**

Pursuant to adjournment, the Council reconvened in the Council Chamber, City Hall on Tuesday, January 14, 1919, at 7 p.m.

Moved by Alderman McBain seconded by Alderman Morden and resolved that the Bylaw entitled "City of North Vancouver General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes Bylaw, 1919" be now reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and City Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal. Whereupon the Bylaw was read and reconsidered, finally adopted, signed by the Mayor and Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal and numbered 398.

Mr. Crehan, City Auditor, submitted the statement of Mr. C.R. Lane, City Treasurer, certified correct, of the liquid assets and current liabilities as at December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1918, also disbursements of Finance Committee, Board of Works Committee, Waterworks Committee, Police committee, School Board, Health Committee, Fire and Light Committee and Parks & Boulevard Committee, also schedule of bonded indebtedness. The above statements were considered at some length and explanations made by the Auditor of various items.

The Auditor stated that during the year the Treasurer had made a saving to eh City of approximately \$9,000.00 in the matter of conversion of bonds, exchange, etc. and that in the matter of exchange alone, he had pretty nearly saved his salary to the City. Mr. Crehan paid a high tribute to the diligence and work of the Treasurer.

Moved by Alderman Morden seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the above statements be received and referred to the Committee of the Whole Council.

At 7:50 p.m. it was moved by Alderman McBain seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the Council adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
