Irwin and resolved that the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to issue a cheque on City's General account, in the amount of \$3,200.00 to pay interest on \$128,000.00 Ferry Debentures due March 10th, which are guaranteed by the City and which amount is to be returned to General account from Ferry account, when funds are available.

Moved by Alderman W.J. Irwin seconded by Alderman Watson and resolved that Mrs. Mary Kenworthy be advised that the Council regrets that it cannot see its way clear to grant the request for permission to tag on the ferries on March 8th in aid of the funds of the Central Mission, Vancouver.

Moved by Alderman T. Irwin seconded by Alderman Evans and resolved that the letter from Messrs. Burns & Walkem, dated February 28th, with respect to having been consulted by Mr. C.T. Haslam, be referred to the City Solicitor for any necessary action.
