

**MINUTES OF ADJOURNED MEETING OF COUNCIL, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, MONDAY, NOVEMBER 10<sup>TH</sup>, 1919 AT 9:00 P.M.**

Moved by Alderman W.J. Irwin seconded by Alderman Watson and resolved that the Council take a short recess to deal with several matters in Committee of the Whole.

At 10:28 His Worship Mayor Vance took the Chair and called the meeting to order.

Moved by Alderman W.J. Irwin seconded by Alderman Evans and resolved that the time of this meeting of Council be extended.

TENDERS were received for the construction of two houses, one for Mr. A.P. May and one for Mr. McGurk.

Moved by Alderman W.J. Irwin seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the lowest tender for the construction of A.P. May's house be accepted, subject to the approval of Mr. May, providing satisfactory arrangements can be made for the difference between the loan and the cost of construction.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the lowest tender for construction of a house for G.W. McGurk be accepted, subject to the approval of Mr. McGurk, providing satisfactory arrangements can be made for the balance.

Moved by Alderman T. Irwin seconded by Alderman Watson and resolved that leave be now granted to introduce at this meeting of the Council, a Bylaw entitled "Treasury

Notes Bylaw, 1919" and that the said Bylaw receive its three several readings at this meeting of the Council, and that the occasion for such three readings be deemed an urgent one within the meaning of the Procedure Bylaw.

Whereupon the Bylaw was introduced and read a first time.

Moved by Alderman Evans seconded by Alderman T. Irwin and resolved that the Bylaw entitled "Treasury Notes Bylaw, 1919" be now read a second time. Whereupon the Bylaw was read a second time.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the Committee proceedings with respect to the "Treasury Notes Bylaw, 1919" be dispensed with.

Moved by Alderman T. Irwin seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the Bylaw entitled "Treasury Notes Bylaw, 1919" be now read a third time.

Whereupon the Bylaw was read a third time and passed by the Council.

Moved by Alderman Townsley seconded by Alderman Evans and resolved that the Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to issue a cheque to W.S.D. Prittie in the amount of \$325.00 out of allotment to him under the "Better Housing Act", to complete purchase of Lot 7, of Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 7, DL 549.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman W.J. Irwin and resolved that the Mayor and City Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to sign an application for the investment of Sinking Funds in Dominion Bonds, said Sinking Funds becoming available by reason of the sale of Treasury Notes against arrears of taxes for 1914, 1915, 1917 and 1918 and that the Mayor and Treasurer be authorized to sign all necessary cheques in connection therewith.

At 11:30 p.m. it was moved by Alderman T. Irwin seconded by Alderman Evans and resolved that the Council adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
