

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4TH, 1920, AT 4:00 P.M.

Notice of Special meeting of the City Council for 4 p.m., Saturday, the 4th September, 1920, for consideration of Ferry matters, which was posted on the front door of the City Hall, on Saturday the 3rd September instant, at 4 p.m. and which was in the following words:

“A Special Meeting of the Council, will be held in the City Hall, on Saturday afternoon, September 4th, at 4 p.m. with respect to Ferry matters, etc. By order of Mayor Vance”.

was read.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the Ferry Firemen receive wages at the rate of \$125.00 per month and 75 cents per hour for overtime, and that the City do not discriminate against the Ferry firemen, wages at increased rate to commence from August 1, 1920.

Moved by Alderman Townsley seconded by Alderman Watson and resolved that the arrangement between the City and the ferry firemen as to increase of wages, be subject to cancellation on one month's notice from either party.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that the Ferry deckhands receive a monthly wage of \$125.00 per month commencing from the 1st of August, 1920, with 75 cents per hour overtime; 9 hours and 40 minutes to constitute a days work, and that the City shall not discriminate against the Ferry deckhands.

Alderman W.J. Irwin voting against.

Moved by Alderman McColl seconded by Alderman Townsley and resolved that Mr. A.C. Sutton be and he is hereby appointed Acting City Clerk, for the purpose of signing copies of the above resolutions.

Moved by Alderman T. Irwin seconded by Alderman Watson and resolved that the council do now resolve itself into Committee of the Whole Council.

IN COMMITTEE

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the Committee do now rise and report progress.

Moved by Alderman Watson seconded by Alderman Irwin and resolved that the Council do now adjourn. Whereupon the Council adjourned.
